

ORDINANCE NO. 487

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 12 "PARKS AND RECREATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS, BY AMMENDING SECTION 12-43 "HOURS" TO PROVIDE UPDATED HOURS OF OPERATION OF CITY OF EL LAGO PARKS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING A PENALTY AS PROVIDED BY SECTION 1-5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS; AND, PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL LAGO, TEXAS:

**SECTION 1.** THAT Section 12-43 "Hours" of Chapter 12 "Parks and Recreation" of the Code of Ordinances, City of El Lago, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows (with all changes being shown in bold font, new language being shown as underlined, and deleted language being shown as struck through):

**"Sec. 12-43 Hours.**

El Lago city parks shall be open seven (7) days a week between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m. and ten o'clock (10:00) p.m.

**SECTION 2.** THAT in the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of El Lago, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.


**SECTION 3.** THAT all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent herewith are, to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** THAT any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine as provided in Section 1-5 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of El Lago.

**SECTION 5.** THAT this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
